<u>Fit Feet</u> increases athletes access to foot care by offering podiatric screenings to evaluate ankles, feet, lower extremity biomechanics, and proper shoe and sock gear to participating athletes. **Clinical Volunteers** such as **Podiatrists**, **clinical foot care specialists**, and **podiatry students** are needed to lead screening and education stations.



<u>Healthy Hearing</u> provides free hearing screenings and other medical services, including ear wax removal, swim molds, hearing aid maintenance and minor repairs for people with intellectual disabilities. <u>Clinical Volunteers</u> such as <u>Audiologists</u>, <u>ENT specialists</u>, <u>GPs</u>, <u>MDs</u>, and technicians.



Opening Eyes provides comprehensive eye assessments, prescription eye wear, sunglasses and sports goggles to Special Olympics athletes and people with intellectual disabilities in general. Clinical Volunteers such as ophthalmologists, optometrists, opticians, optometry students, optometry and ophthalmology residents, ophthalmic technicians, Lions Clubs members, and general volunteers.
