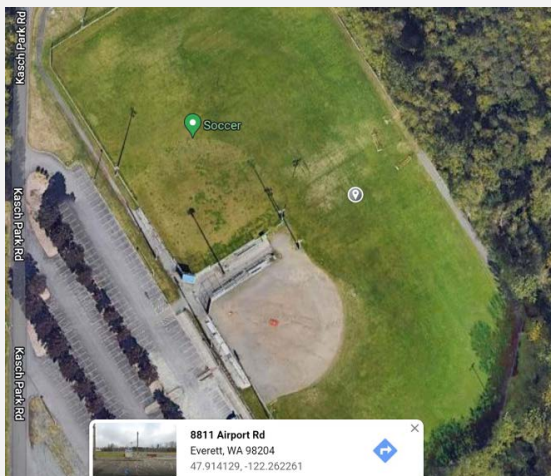

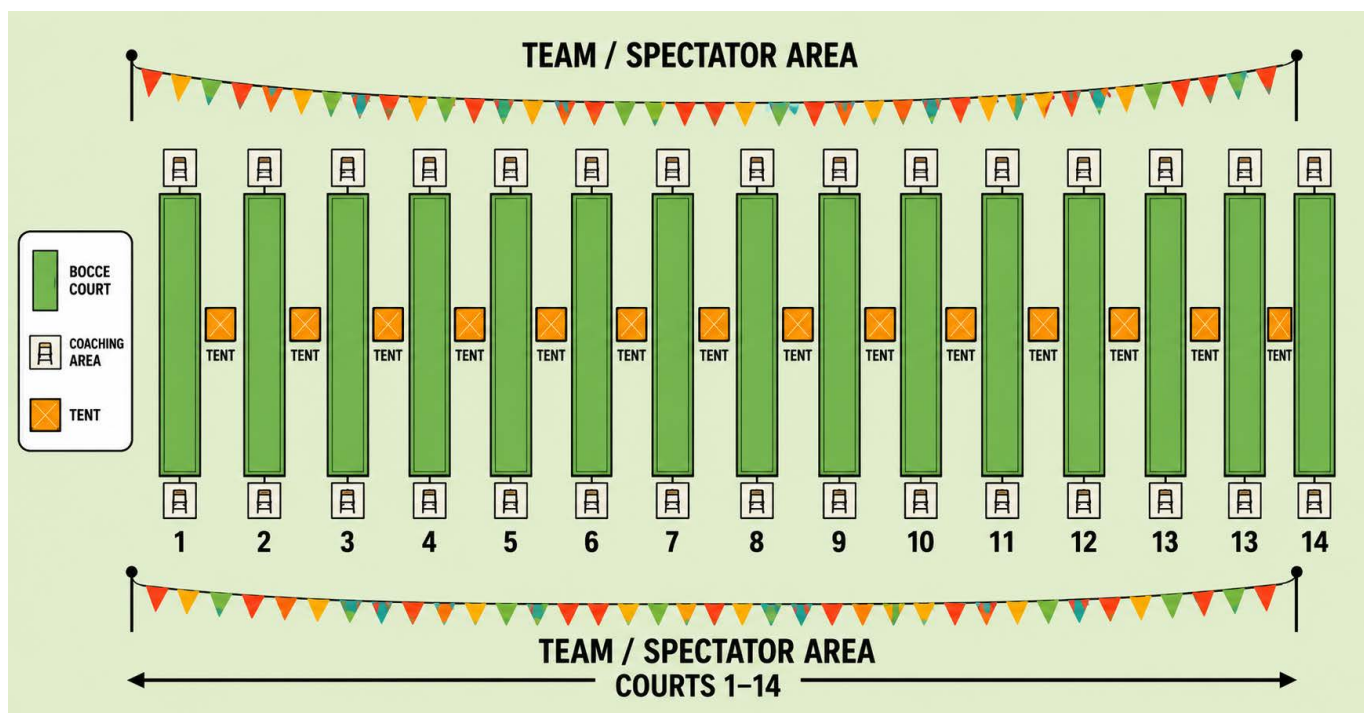
Bocce

VENUE OVERVIEW

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This layout reflects the standard bocce court setup for our events. Although individual venues may require minor modifications due to space or field conditions, all bocce competitions will be held on **grass courts**.



- Please avoid using stakes in the grass whenever possible. Instead, use tent weights to secure all tents.
- Tents may be set up anywhere behind the designated Team/Spectator Areas, which will be clearly marked with flags.
- Modified Courts/Ramp Courts will be located closest to Court 1.
- Court 14 will be available for practice when it is not being used for scheduled competition.
- Court 1 will be reserved for volunteer training prior to the start of competition. Please keep this area clear until the volunteer meeting has concluded.
- Coaches are reminded that no coaching is permitted once athletes enter the competition area, except during an official timeout.
