Health Promotion uses health screenings, interactive educational tools and displays, motivational literature, and demonstrations to heighten the awareness of athletes, reinforcing the need to improve and maintain an enhanced level of wellness and self-care. It also provides screening for BMI, blood pressure, and bone density.

Physician Equivalent Volunteers including **Dietitians, Nutritionists, MD's, Nurses, Dermatologists, Public Health Educators** will lead nutrition, BMI, bone health, sun safety, tobacco avoidance, hygiene and physical activity screenings and education stations.

Student Volunteers including **professionals or undergraduate students in a wellness field** such as public health, nutrition, or fitness will assist with screening and education stations as well as check in and out.
