

#### PROTEST FORM

Requirements and Instructions

The Official Special Olympics Sports Rules ("Sports Rules") provide standards for Special Olympics training and competition. Article I provides general principles established by the Special Olympics Official General Rules.

Article 1, Section 8.3 outlines the specific guidelines for Protests and Appeals.

#### PROTESTABLE OFFENCES

- Misinterpretation of sport rules
- · Failure of a referee/official or judge to apply the correct rule
- · Failure to impose the correct penalty for a violation



#### NON-PROTESTABLE OFFENCES

- · Fact-specific judgment calls of referees, judges or officials
- · Divisioning and meaning full involvement decisions

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING THE FORM

- Only a Head Coach or his/her designee (in the absence of a Head Coach) may file a
  protest or appeal
- Each protest must identify the relevant section number of the official Special Olympics Sport Rules, ISP or NGB rules. The protest must clearly describe how that rule has been violated.
- The Head Coach has 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event/race/game to file the protest at the Command Table on site.
- The Event Director or Sports Jury shall review the protest. Once the Event Director or Sports Jury has made it's decision the coach will then be notified of the outcome.
