






Questions?



Q: Are we doing the "best effort" DQ this year?

A: No, this is not something we are able to accommodate.

Q: Shouldn't the Assisted Swim in Category A be 15 meters instead of 10?

A: Our understanding is that we compete in the 10 Meter because of staging in the pool — there is not an easy way to get into the small pool, so we leave a buffer in the small pool.

Q: Is there a reason a swimmer in Category B who can do an unassisted swim (but not any of the specific strokes) can't do a 15-meter walk? Otherwise, that swimmer can only do 1 event.

A: Categories were developed LONG ago. They were originally meant to support skill development and management of the competition. We actually have made adjustments to categories in the past, but this usually takes an annual review. We wouldn't be able to update this for 2023, but this is being placed in my feedback form for a review for 2024.

Q: If you want Category B to be for swimmers who are a little more capable than those in Category A you could have a 25-meter walk.

A: The challenge with the 25M events like the flotation is that it is in the large pool, while all shorter events are actually in the little pool.

Q: How do we identify athletes that have a physical disability, so they do not get DQ based on their physical inability to do strokes, starts, turns etc.?

A: Working to provide programs by middle of next week with a SOWA approved exception code list. These codes would then be written on the upper arm of the athlete on competition day to indicate to the judges what their exception may be, so they don't get DQ based on physical disabilities.

Q: What flotation devices are allowed for the flotation races?

A: Please see section 3.2 Equipment/sub section 3.2.5 for what flotation devices are allowed during competition.
