

COVID-19 “Code-of-Conduct” and “Waiver” form Addendum

Beginning May 28th, 2021, the below amendments regarding the [COVID-19 Code-of-Conduct](#) and [Waiver form](#) will become in affect.

- All participants (*Athletes, Unified Partners, Class-A Volunteers, and Safety Squad Members*) are required to complete and sign both the COVID-19 Code-of-Conduct and Waiver form before participating in any in-person activities.
- It is strongly encouraged that both forms be reviewed, signed, and submitted to Special Olympics Washington along with the Program’s Final Registration by July 1st. Those not able to submit their COVID-19 Code-of-Conduct and Waiver forms prior to their first practice are able to complete and sign both forms upon checking in on-site, but before being allowed to participate. It is the Safety Squad Member’s responsibility to ensure all participants are listed on the approved roster and have all completed forms on-file before being allowed to participate.
- All COVID-19 Code-of-Conduct and Waiver forms completed on-site are required to be submitted to the Sr. Manager of Sports and Competition, or along with the respective Contact Tracing form submitted online within 24 hours of the practice.
- All participants are only required to complete and sign the COVID-19 Code-of-Conduct and Waiver form once. Both forms will cover said individual for the entirety of the Summer Season.
- The below paperwork is not included in this addendum and is required to be completed and submitted to Special Olympics Washington by July 1st. Those who do not have the below listed current paperwork by July 1st will not be approved to participate this Summer Season.
